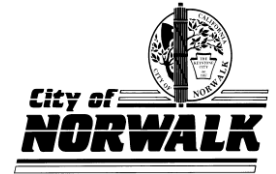

2. UNCLASSIFIED USE NO. 15

3. DIRECTION REGARDING ANIMAL PERMITS FOR CATS, DOGS, BIRDS, AND SMALL MAMMALS

Staff Recommendation: That the Planning Commission provide policy direction in regard to the maximum number of

cats, dogs, birds, and small mammals that can be administratively approved through the animal permit process.
