Project Description: For the Planning Commission to consider the following application filed by Jose Ponce, Ponce Recycling Inc.; a request to relocate an existing recycling collection facility within the same shopping center. The subject property is generally known as Norwalk Plaza Shopping Center, 11660 Firestone Boulevard, at the southwest intersection of Firestone Boulevard and Pioneer Boulevard, in the General Commercial (C-3) zone.

Environmental Review Information: Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the local CEQA Guidelines of the City of Norwalk, this project will not have a significant effect on the environment and is listed as a Class 3 Categorical Exemption. Class 3 consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures.
