PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 17-1695 ADOPTING BY REFERENCE AND AMENDING THE 2017 LOS ANGELES COUNTY FIRE CODE

Description: The Norwalk City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider the adoption of proposed Ordinance No. 17-1695, **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORWALK ADOPTING BY REFERENCE AND AMENDING, TITLE 32 OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY CODE (THE 2017 FIRE CODE) INCORPORATING THE 2016 CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE AND 2015 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, AS AMENDED; AND AMENDING THE NORWALK MUNICIPAL CODE**, which repeals and replaces Chapter 15.08 of the Norwalk Municipal Code and adopts Title 32, Fire Code of the Los Angeles County Code as adopted by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and in effect on February 23, 2017, adopting and amending the California Fire Code, 2016 edition, including Appendices as specified in Section 101.2.1 of the Los Angeles County Fire Code, and adopting certain portions of the International Fire Code, 2015 edition. Ordinance No. 17-1695 modifies the code to provide for specific local climatic, geologic and topographic conditions.
