The City of Norwalk Hometown Heroes Banner recognition program is designed to honor current military personnel who reside in Norwalk, or are a family member of a Norwalk resident. The City recognizes their service and commitment to our nation and our community with a banner as a public expression of gratitude.

Honoree must be a member of any branch of the United States Military Services, currently serving on active duty or an active reservist.

Service person must be a resident or family member of a Norwalk resident. Family member must be immediate (i.e. brother, sister, spouse, parent, grandchild).

Military banners will be on display on Firestone Boulevard. Banner will be removed from display and returned to the family/honoree, one year from posting date. Return of the banner to the family or service person will take place at a City Council meeting.
